





Road Safety Awareness and Pre-Hospital Care Training Program in Rajasthan



PROPOSED PROJECT'S MISSION

Minimize the morbidity and mortality rate occurring due to unawareness of traffic rules and pre hospital care in the state of Rajasthan.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES :

- i) Generate mass awareness and sensitization of community about traffic rules and regulation and to come forward to the rescue of accident victims without fear of police and legal involvement.
- ii) Formation of Live Saver Groups (LS) and enrolment of Live Savers (LS) from different stakeholders and groups across the state of Rajasthan for the rescue and timely help of road accident victims.
- iii) Imparting training to general public including LS members, villagers, panchayat raj representatives, dhaba employee, petrol pump workers, police personnel, community liaison groups (CLG), medical / paramedical staff of government and private hospital, school / college student on saving a life by giving various training course in whole body injury management including Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).
- iv) Formation of First Aid Posts at specific locations with the help of LS on highways (in second phase).
- v) Organizing camps, rallies, quiz competitions, slide shows, nukkad natak (IEC Activities – Information, Education and Communication) for increasing awareness regarding road safety.
- vi) Teaching Psychological and Legal aspects for helping accident victims.

TRAINING

FIRST AID TRAINING

A course on road and life safety is recommended for the general public, LS member, CLG members, volunteers, students, office staff, medical and paramedical staff, businessmen, drivers and conductors (private and RSRTC) etc. These trainings will be organized in cities of Rajasthan, on highways and police stations across the proposed areas of Rajasthan.

In second phase each LS member will be given primary health care kit containing emergency medicines, gloves, cotton, bandages etc. to be used for immediate use at the accident site. First aid training will enable them to be confident in caring and transporting an accident case even in the absence of a police aid if need arises.

Each LS member will be expected to call for necessary help and work in close coordination with local police and hospital authorities. The relevant telephone numbers should be made available to the LS member.

Quarterly life saver group meetings :

In second phase quarterly meetings of live saver (LS) members shall be held at respective local police thanas to sensitize/orient and enhance constant co-ordination between the identified members and police personnel. The emphasis will be made to analyze the progress of the project and each member will be made accountable for his work so as to render collective support to an injured and save maximum numbers of lives.

Information Education Communication (IEC) Activities :

It is very important component of the proposed project. Once the accident occurs, usually injured victims have to depend helplessly on sympathetic by standers. It is always the persons passing by or working there or living near the site who are the first to attend to them. The Neurotrauma Society Jaipur proposes to organize awareness generation camps to random gathering in markets, villages, family under the proposed project areas. The other IEC activities would be school rallies, nukkad natak / street plays and quiz's and painting competition in schools and colleges which will enable our future generation of students to strengthen the cause and in which their involvement will be necessary.



METHODOLOGY:

We propose to organize following activities in the proposed divisions of Rajasthan on which various aspects of road accidents right from prevention to response shall be dealt with.

Activities IEC (Information Education Communication)

Involve all activities by which awareness can be spread amongst the public.

Activities

Awareness Camps

Knowledge of road safety norms and first aid training would be imparted randomly at places where approaches to mass community is accessible like dhaba and petrol pump workers, businessmen residing on highways, village sarpanch.

Street play / nukkad natak

To be organized in school, villages and crowded places on the roadside attracting a large gathering.

Media Publicity

All activities would be publicized in print as well as electronic media so that more and more people will become aware about the project activities. Media personnel will also be requested to print articles and make stories on the success of the project.

First aid posts

In second phase, first aid posts would be put up and manned by LS from the local community. These posts will be located in public call offices (PCOs) and shops with a telephone along major accident spots of selected region and in some congested parts where roads are heavy with traffic.

TOPICS TO BE DISCUSSED

Accident a scenario

Various types of traffic norms and safe driving measures to be followed on roads :

- Basic injury managements by laymen at accident site
- Life saving methods including "Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation" (CPR)
- Legal inputs as per motor vehicle act 1988
- Awareness to strengthen the enforcement of Law
- Psychological aspects of accidents

TRAINING FORMAT :

The training courses consist of lectures, slide shows, video shows and practical training session. The trainees are given a chance to perfect the life-saving measures by practice on a human mannequin called "SKILLMETER RESUSCIANNE" for teaching the methods of cardiopulmonary resuscitation popularly called CPR which means revival of heart and lungs if they stop due to heart attack, blood loss or shock.

PROJECT OUTLAY :

The proposed project envisages covering selected divisions of the state of Rajasthan. The major interventions are assessment, survey, IEC activities, training and first aid posts.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES:

The program is designed to have wider impact for creating awareness, capacity building of community, promoting community based primary health care for accident victims in reducing accident mortality and morbidity in Rajasthan.

Community participating will have long term sustainable impact in improving risk behaviour, road safety measures and remove social apathy of general public towards extending help and supports to accident victims.



SPECIFIC IMPACT

Awareness generation activities will improve road safety measures through the genera community and drivers, which will help reduce accidents. Community organization activities will develop a sense of social responsibility and confidence in coming forward to help stranded accident victims. Communication network and arrangement of primary care provided by organization and supported by volunteers will substantially reduce accident mortality in selected divisions.

RESULT ANTICIPATED

Road accidents constitute a major share of human unnatural deaths which can be brought into the main stream by discussion among planners and policy makers of the country. The project shall aim to educate the drivers which shall lesson the number of the accidents. The number of death will be reduced as proper treatment methods shall be provided to traffic police and other departments as also to the general public.

प्री-हॉस्पिटल केयर की दी जा रही है ट्रेनिंग

संयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ ने वर्ष 2011 से 2020 तक को डिकेड ऑफ एक्शन फॉर रोड सेफ्टी घोषित किया है। सड़क दुर्घटना में घायल व्यक्ति को सही समय पर मदद मिल सके, इसके लिए आम लोगों व पुलिस को प्री-हॉस्पिटल केयर की जानकारी होना जरूरी है।

इसी को ध्यान में रखते हुए एसएमएस हॉस्पिटल के डॉक्टर्स की न्यूरो ट्रामा सोसाइटी व सेंटर फॉर रोड सेफ्टी, सरदार पटेल पुलिस यूनिवर्सिटी की ओर से प्री-हॉस्पिटल केयर की ट्रेनिंग दी जा रही है। इसके

लिए उन्होंने सबसे पहले जयपुर-किशनगढ़ एक्सप्रेस हाईवे को चुना, जहां सबसे ज्यादा सड़क दुर्घटनाएं होती हैं। साथ ही इन स्पॉट्स पर वॉलंटियर्स को भी तैयार किया जा रहा है, जो किसी भी दुर्घटना वाले स्थान पर पुलिस के साथ मिलकर घायलों की मदद कर सकें। हर स्पॉट पर एक फ़र्स्ट एड सेंटर खोला जाएगा, जिसका संचालन इन वॉलंटियर्स व स्थानीय पुलिस द्वारा किया जाएगा व वॉलंटियर्स को न्यूरो ट्रामा सोसाइटी की ओर से भी फ़र्स्ट एड किट दिया जाएगा। अभी तक 2 स्थानों पर प्री-हॉस्पिटल केयर ट्रेनिंग दी जा चुकी है।

Pre-Hospital Care Training at Bagru on 1st July 2014

After conducting 3 First Aid training at Badke Balaji, Dehmikala and Chitroli Cut, one combined refresher training on Pre Hospital Care for all trainees of 3 spots along with other social workers, media and businessmen were conducted at Bagru on 1st July 2014. About 200 persons across the bagru region were benefitted from the training on Pre-Hospital Care Hotel Highway King, Bagru, Jaipur. Dr. V.D. Sinha, Neurosurgeon focussed on the present scenario of Pre Hospital Care in India and also compared it with other developing countries. He stressed on the Golder hour concept and told that on 20% patient reach to the hospital within one hour. He also told that by using Helmet and Seat Belt while driving two / four-wheeler can save their lives by head and abdominal injuries. Dr. Amit Chakraborty, Neurosurgeon have taught participant about Pre-Hospital Care techniques in details with the help of powerpoint presentation. Then, Mrs. Prerna Singh have shown some movies on bandages techniques used in open fracture, amputation and abdomen injuries etc. Dr. Bhupindra Singh, IPS, Pro VC, SPUP and Centre Director Shri Manoj Bhatt, IPS informed gathering about Centre's activities and motivated them to come forward to rescue and give pre hospital care to the injured while transporting to the hospital. Participants also shares their vies on the problem. One first aid post at Badke Balaji has been launched at the ceremony and given First Aid Box and Display Board to Mr. Sayarmal Mistri who have come forward and offered to establish First Aid post at his show which is on the highway itself.

यह बहुत प्रारंभिक रूप की जगह-अन्तर्मित उन्नयन पर विभिन्न एक हाइटल में एस्टरेट्स हॉस्पिटल के न्यूरो स्पेशलिस्ट शूटिंग हेल एवं ब्यूट्रोम सोसायटी के समिति द्वारा विनियोग ने कही। एस्टरेट्स अस्पताल के न्यूरो ट्रॉम सोसायटी जबपु, मेन्टर फॉर रोड सेफ्टी तथा समाज फॉर युवाओं सुनिक्षिप्तों के समूक तथा उच्चशास्त्रीय एवं सामाजिक दुर्घटना स्ट्रिट्स को बुरा या है। इन 10 हूफ्टना समूहों के अस्पताल राहने वाले ड्रायवर्स लेन्जों एवं सम्बद्धियों पुरिस थाना के नक्शों को प्री हॉस्पिटल केयर का प्रशिक्षण दिया जा रहा है।

Pre-Hospital Care Training for 108 Ambulance Staff on 19th August 2014 at RPA, Jaipur


In Pre-Hospital Care process, role of 108 Ambulance staff is very crucial. Thus one refresher training on Pre Hospital Care was conducted at Conference Hall of Rajasthan Police Academy in close coordination of Centre for Road Safety, SPUP. Dr. V.D. Singh, Neurosurgeon focused in the present scenario of Pre-Hospital Care in India and also compared it with other developing countries. He stressed on the Golden hour concept and told that only 20% patient reach to the hospital within an hour. He revealed that the 108 Ambulance services are better in Rajasthan and it helps in the reach time of patient to hospital with golden period. He also explained about the triage concept of emergency management. He also told that by using Helmet and Seat Belt while driving two / four wheeler can save their lives by head and abdominal injuries. Dr. Amit Chakraborty, Neurosurgeon have taught participants about Pre-Hospital Care techniques in details with the help of powerpoint presentation. He also stressed to ambulance staff to call to the hospital prior to reaching and should explain the condition of the patient to the hospital staff, so that the response time at the hospital will drop down which will be benefitted in the lifesaving process of the patient. Then, Ms. Prerna Singh & Raj Singh gave practical demonstration on CPR on Adult, Child and Infant with the help of human mannequin. Sh. Sudhakar Jauhari, ADGP (Traffic), Rajasthan Police appreciated the efforts taken by Neurotrauma Society and Centre for Road Safety, SPUP in bringing down the mortality and morbidity rate of road and other accidents by educating general public Pre-Hospital Care techniques. He told to 108 employees that they should know to identify the various types of injuries and should take patient to the concerned specialist nearest hospital so that more lives could be saved, He also supported that 108 ambulance staff should give prior information to the concerned hospital about the condition of patient which will reduce the response time at the hospital. Mr. Hiren Bhatt, State Head, GVK EMRI informed about the current status of 108 Ambulance i.e. total 649 Ambulances are operational in the State of Rajasthan. He said that presently all ambulances are on Basic Life Support system, however very soon Advance Life Support system ambulances will be working in the state. He appreciated the efforts and also said that this type of training will also be organized in the future for other 108 ambulance staff. Dr. Amit Chakrabarty gave vote of thanks to everyone.



Spreading the message of hope

World Day of Remembrance for road traffic victims was observed at JKK on Saturday

The World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims (WDR) was observed on Saturday at Jawahar Kala Kendra. The event was organised by Muskaan and was themed on 'Love, Hope and Positive Action'. The evening witnessed several activities that spread this message among the audience. It is worth noting that the WDR was adopted by the UN as an "appropriate acknowledgement for victims of road traffic crashes and their families".

The chief guest on the occasion was CEO, ZEE Regional Channels, Jagdeesh Chandra and the Guest of Honour was CEO and MD, AU Small Finance Bank, Sanjay Agarwal.

On the occasion, Managing Trustee, Muskaan, Mridul Bhasin said that around 150,000 people lose lives annually in road accidents. She further said that Muskaan is committed to the aim of reducing road accidents by 50 per cent by the year 2022, which is also one of the missions of the UN.

During the event, interactive sessions with road accident victims as well as relatives of the deceased were also held which spread the message of turning mishap into positive action. Popularly known as "traffic heroine", Dorris Francis was also a part of one of the sessions along with her husband Victor Francis. Although not a police officer, Dorris Francis manages traffic from 7.30 am to 11 am at an intersection on NH 24 in Gharialab. The intersection has a special significance for her because one of her daughters, Nikki, died in an accident there in 2009.

Parents of 21 year old Dikshant Thadani - who lost his life in an accident in August this year - were also a part of one of the sessions. They shared how the MFJCF Navjeevan team counseled their family members to donate the organs of Dikshant to which they agreed. Dikshant's kidneys, heart and liver were transplanted on patients suffering from various organ failures.




